Personally, Social, Character Development

The traits that we will be focusing on this term are perseverance, celebrating differences, self-regulation, positive relationships, healthy mind, social responsibility and understanding others. It would be great if you could discuss these with your child at home.

History, Geography & Social Understanding

As part of our History learning, children will be asked to create timelines of their own lives and place these in context within greater world history.

As part of our Geography learning, children will use Google Earth to compare the UK with another country around the world that they may be familiar with. Children will also explore their own cultural history and their family's heritage.

Science and Technological Understanding

This term we will be looking at changes in development of humans throughout time. This will be linked to our genes and our own family trees. As part of our topic learning, please support your child with finding out as much as possible about their family tree. We will be creating family trees in Week 2.

Understanding the Arts

The children will be looking at a range of artists such as Lois Mailou Jones and Frida Kahlo, as inspiration for their own self-portraits. We will be focussing on how we can create different textures.

Computing

In computing this term we will be focusing on using google slides to create interesting multimedia presentations.

Understanding English, Communication & Language

This term will be focussing on writing a recount. The children will take part in an exciting local trip, which they will use as stimulus for their written recounts using all the techniques they learn throughout the term.

Mathematical Understanding

Measures

This term we will be focusing on coordinates in all four quadrants.

Number and Calculation

We will be starting the year off with place value, addition & subtraction methods and statistics. The children will then be applying these methods in answering word problems. It is really important that children are practising their number facts at home.

PE this term will be focusing on Cricket and multi-skills! These are both team sports so children will be practising their collaboration skills.
