Personally, Social, Character Development

The traits that we will be focusing on this term are healthy body, healthy mind, hope, teamwork, appreciation and judgement. It would be great if you could discuss these with your child at home.

History, Geography & Social Understanding

This term we will be using our historical enquiry skills to find out about World War II. We will be focusing on the impact of the war both on a worldwide scale, but specifically how it impacted London and our local area, Stockwell.

Understanding English, Communication & Language

This term, children will be learning all about how to write a persuasive letter, linking this to our topic book 'Friend or Foe'. This will require children to use a range of different techniques that we will be practising during our writing sessions.

Year 6 will also be writing setting descriptions based on 'The Blitz', diary entries and a war poem.

Literacy skills will continue to work as a carousel however we have also planned in lots of whole class reading activities with lots of interactive activities.

Understanding the Arts

Children will be building their own Anderson shelter. They will be using their learning from science to put an electrical circuit inside so that there is a light. Children will be using DT skills to build their Anderson shelter, including wood-work.
