History, Geography & Social Understanding

During our history topic this term we will be exploring Ancient Greece and the way life worked in this time. We will also be making lots of comparisons to modern day and how these changes have happened over the years with a focus on the Olympic Games.

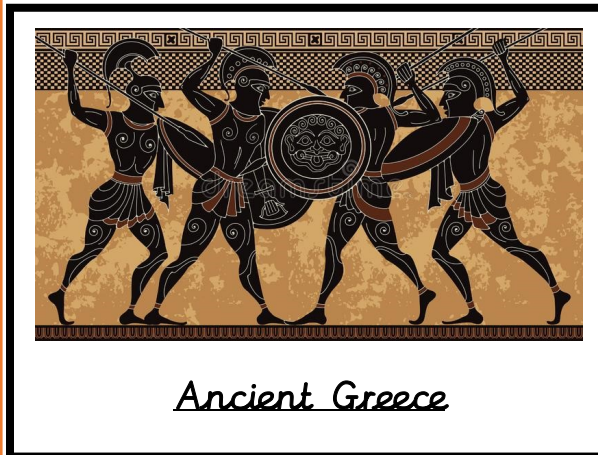
Linked to OAA Day we will be revising our knowledge of maps and atlases. We will learn all about using compasses, grid references and create our own maps.

Science and Technological Understanding

Our focus for Science this term will be on healthy bodies, diet and exercise. We will be using this knowledge to write a healthy living leaflet. We will also consolidate our learning about the heart.

Understanding the Arts

This term, we will be studying Ancient Greek pottery as a primary source of evidence in history. We will then apply this learning to create our own clay sculptures inspired by Ancient Greek mythology.

Cooking

This term we will be expanding our design and technology knowledge by focusing on cooking. We will learn all about what seasonality means in relation to food. We will then plan, make and evaluate our own seasonal meal making links to our scientific learning about healthy bodies and diet.

Understanding English, Communication & Language

For this term, we will be looking at a range of writing genres. We will work collaboratively to create a play script. We will also write information texts and poetry. Our assessed write this term will be a diary entry in role as Odysseus.

Our key text this term is The Adventures of Odysseus by Hugh Lupton.

Mathematical Understanding

In Maths this term we will be focusing first on Geometry. We will learn about properties of shape, thinking about angles, polygons and 3-D shape. We will then learn about position and direction with a focus on translation, coordinates, lines of symmetry and reflection. We will then revise and build upon our knowledge of decimals.

In topic learning we will make links with Maths as we create graphs and convert time.

Understanding Physical Health

In P.E this term we will continue to develop our movement skills as we build upon our Cricket skills learnt in Autumn. We will also be applying our skills in Rugby. P.E will continue to take place on a Monday and a Friday.
